# Catholic Facts:

Join us as we learn more about our faith each week....

The origin of the word "Catholic" (from the Greek word meaning universal) was used very early in the church. St. Ignatius of Antioch {37-107 A.D.} used it in a letter to describe how the Church reaches out to all people everywhere. The term "catholic" was used in the Apostles Creed [2<sup>nd</sup> Century], "I believe in the holy Catholic Church." In the Nicene Creed [4<sup>th</sup> century] the church is described as "One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic."

Are Catholics Christian?

YES! Christianity is the religion which comes from the teachings of Jesus Christ. The word "Christian" is used only three times in the New Testament. For over 1000 years there was just one Christian Church and that church was the Catholic Church.

Christianity, today is made up of Roman Catholics, Orthodox, and Protestants. So, the only Christian Church which dates back to Jesus Christ and His apostles is the Roman Catholic Church. All other Christian Churches can trace their origin back to the Catholic Church.

## What is Pentecost Sunday?

On the Feast of Pentecost, Christians commemorate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, gathered around the Mother of the Lord (Acts of the Apostles chapter 2). The feast is celebrated on the 50th and final day of the Easter season.

In 2025, Pentecost falls on Sunday, June 8.

## What is the story of Pentecost?

The eleven remaining Apostles returned to Jerusalem after the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven. Acts 1:14 says, "All these with one accord devoted themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren." During this time, the Apostles chose a replacement for Judas Iscariot. They cast lots between two men, and the lot fell on Matthias.

After nine days of prayer, the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples. They heard a sound like a "mighty wind," and "tongues as of fire" were resting on their heads.

Going out, Peter spoke to the crowd that had gathered. Even though, just a few weeks earlier, he had denied Christ three times, Peter courageously proclaimed the Gospel. That day, three thousand people believed in Christ and were received into His Church.

# Flaming Strawberries

FOR THE SOLEMNITY OF THE SACRED HEART OR PENTECOST

- Ingredients
1. Fresh Strawberries
  2. Any alcohol that is at least 80 proof, for a fail proof flame use Bacardi 151 (I just went with this)
  3. Cupcakes with Icing
  4. Lighter

Start by washing your fresh strawberries!

Take your strawberry corer and remove the center. Alternatively, you can use a butter knife but try to avoid puncturing the strawberry. If you do accidentally poke a hole in the sides or bottom do not use it for your flame, just eat it and move on.

The strawberry should fit firmly into the icing so that we don't have any accidents! A heap of icing will do the trick, no need to overthink it.

Using a shot glass pour your alcohol of choice into the strawberry until almost filled to the top. We don't want it to overflow but the goal is for the flame to sit atop the strawberry so it can be easily seen.

Light it up and enjoy the oooooohhhh ... aaaahhhhhhhhhh. Blow out before eating, don't be a goofball!

- (10) I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- (11) Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in my Heart.
- (12) I promise you in the excessive mercy of my Heart that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in my disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. My divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment."
